As you step beyond the PADI Open Water Diver level, you make five dives and have the opportunity to try some of diving's most rewarding and useful specialty activities, such as navigation, night diving, deep diving, wreck diving and drift diving. These skills make diving much more than underwater sightseeing. Plus, the Advanced Open Water Diver course takes you one step closer to Master Scuba Diver – the ultimate non-professional certification in recreational diving.

With your PADI Instructor, you'll complete the 5 Adventure Dives. These dives boost your confidence as you build these foundational skills. Each Adventure Dive in the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course may credit toward the first dive of the corresponding PADI Specialty Diver course (ie: Deep, Wreck, Night, etc.)

Required Equipment List: In addition to the PADI Adventures in Diving Manual, you'll need all of your basic Scuba gear including: mask, snorkel and fins/boots. You'll also need your RDP (ie: Tables), whistle, SMB and 1 primary dive light. A dive knife or cutting tool is also recommended.

Gear included in the course price is an exposure suit, weights, regulator with SPG & alternate air source, BCD, computer, compass, tanks and all air fills.

Prerequisites:

- Open Water or Junior Open Water Certification (must be over 12)
- For the night dive (and others like Deep), you will need your own primary dive light. Several specials are available at FNF. A tank light is also recommended.

Cost: \$379 Course + Advanced Crew Pack - price includes all rental gear and all air fills for the course.
