Pre-requisites: PADI (or equivalent) Advanced Certification (must be over 15) + Current CPR/First Aid from a valid certifying agency or PADI's EFR course (see below) + the Emergency Oxygen Provider course (or equivalent). Both are offered through the shop on a regular basis.
