Are you looking for something extraordinary? It's about life transformations—both yours and those around you. The fun part of instructor training is interacting with fellow course participants. The challenging part of this course is your personal commitment to the training. The course requires you to self-study before the course begins and to prepare daily assignments for teaching presentations. Organization and dedication are the keys to success. You will participate in a series of curriculum presentations; along with demonstrating competence at the 24 water skills, the 800 metres swim, rescue techniques, dive theory, and PADI standards.

The PADI Instructor Development Course crew-pack includes all the materials needed to prepare for the Instructor Development Course.

## PREREQUISITES

- Be certified as a PADI Divemaster or a PADI Assistant Instructor or be an instructor in good standing with another training organization for at least six months Be certified as an Emergency First Response Instructor (or Instructor from another qualified agency).
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Be certified as a diver for at least six months
- Have 60 logged dives that include experience in night, deep and navigation diving to participate in the Instructor Development Course. You'll need 100 logged dives to take the Instructor Exams.
- Have proof of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months.
- Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.

After becoming an Open Water Scuba Instructor, you will be able to conduct a wide variety of PADI programs. You may also choose to acquire specialty instructor ratings in areas of interest, such as Digital Underwater Photographer or Enriched Air Diver.

The cost of the Instructor Development Program is \$1800.00. This does not include the cost of the Emergency First Response instructor program. The EFR Instructor Program is \$300 plus materials. The cost of the IDC crew pack and the EFR instructor materials can be obtained from the staff at Float N' Flag. Dive Theory Online is also highly recommended and estimated at \$150.
