## **PREREQUISITES**

- Be certified as a PADI Divernaster or a PADI Assistant Instructor or be an instructor in good standing with another training organization for at least six months Be certified as an Emergency First Response Instructor (or Instructor from another qualified agency).
- Be at least 18 years old.
- Be certified as a diver for at least six months.
- Have 60 logged dives that include experience in night, deep and navigation diving to participate in the Instructor Development Course. You'll need 100 logged dives to take the Instructor Exams.
- Have proof of CPR and First Aid training within the last 24 months.
- Be fit for diving and submit a Medical Statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months.

After becoming an Open Water Scuba Instructor, you will be able to conduct a wide variety of PADI programs. You may also choose to acquire specialty instructor ratings in areas of interest, such as Digital Underwater Photographer or Enriched Air Diver.

The cost of the Instructor Development Course is \$1,800. This does not include the cost of the materials, the Emergency First Response instructor program and it's materials, application fees and Instructor Exam fees. These will all be discussed/summarized at the info session so you have a clear understanding of both time and financial commitments.
