

2020 DEEP DIVER



Sept 9th Class, Sept 10th Skills dive, Sept 12th & 13th OW Dives

The Deep Diver Specialty course offers you the opportunity of a lifetime - going deep to see things others can only dream about. In this course you will experience what it's like to dive beyond 60 feet. Down there, it's different. It takes additional training. Here's where you get it.

- Advanced/Adventure Diver or qualifying certification from another organization) and 15 years old.
- Learn deep dive planning, organization, procedures, techniques and hazards. Also learn about different equipment such as pony/stage bottles, H-valves, Doubles and more. You'll try some of this equipment in practice sessions.
- Four open water dives that range from 60 - 130 feet.
- Gain experience with diving deep under the direct, professional supervision of a PADI Instructor.
- Required Equipment List: In addition to the PADI Deep Diver Specialty Manual, you'll need all of your basic Scuba gear including: mask, fins, snorkel, exposure suit (drysuit recommended), weights, regulator with SPG & alternate air source, BCD, computer, dive knife or tool, slate with pencil plus compass, whistle, SMB and 2 lights (primary & back-up). You'll also need a reel and a set of the PADI RDP (ie: Tables). Your Instructor may suggest other gear appropriate for deep diving in your area or other locations you may be considering.
- Certification counts toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating.

Prerequisites: PADI (or equivalent) Advanced Certification (must be over 15)

Cost: \$340 Course + Deep Diver Specialty manual @ \$60 + Accommodations & Charter fees as required in Tobermory (approximately \$400)

Schedule:

Session 1 @ 6:00pm - Classroom at Float N' Flag Dive Centre.

Session 2 @ 5:00pm - Gullivers - Pre-trip skills dive.

Session 3+4 - Dives will be held in Tobermory. Hotel Rooms are already booked, and the charters have been arranged already (AM for Sat and AM for Sunday).

Note to Participants: Additional details will be provided for you regarding the charter and accommodations. You will be responsible to pay for accommodation, travel and charter costs. Air/Nitrox fills are also student responsibilities.
