
DRY SUIT DIVER







Wanna stay warm and toasty on a dive? Then stay out of the water. What? Stay out of the water? Yes! Unlike a wetsuit, a dry suit seals you off from the outside water. In the PADI Dry Suit Diver Specialty course, you'll learn how to use a dry suit. And that keeps you warm! Even in very cold water.

- Must be a PADI Open Water Diver or Junior Open Water Diver (or hold a qualifying certification from another training organization) and at least 12 years old
- · Don and doff techniques specific to your dry suit
- Dry suit buoyancy control skills
- · Dry suit maintenance and storage
- Undergarment options (fleece or overall-type garments worn under the dry suit)
- The PADI Dry Suit Diver certification credits toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating

Prerequisites: Open Water or Junior Open Water Certification (must be over 12)

Cost: e-learning Module = \$164+tx plus the course fee (including drysuit review and fitting session, Pool orientation dive and 2 Open Water Dives) = \$200+tx

You must have your own Dry suit to take this course. All divers will purchase the e-learning module, but the course fee (\$200) is FREE with the purchase of a Dry Suit from Float N' Flag. We do not rent drysuits at this time.
