- Dive accident scenarios
- Minimum Age: 15 years old (12 for PADI Junior Rescue Diver)

**Pre-requisites:** PADI (or equivalent) Advanced Certification (must be over 15) + CPR/First Aid from a valid certifying agency or PADI's EFR course within 24 months + the Emergency Oxygen Provider course (or equivalent). Both are offered through the shop on a regular basis. See below.
