

2025 DEEP DIVER



Sept 8th Class, Sept 10th Skills Dive, Sept 12th - 14th Deep Dives

The Deep Diver Specialty course offers you the opportunity of a lifetime - going deep to see things others can only dream about. In this course you will experience what it's like to dive beyond 60 feet. Down there, it's different. It takes additional training. Here's where you get it.

- Advanced/Adventure Diver or qualifying certification from another organization) and 15 years old.
- Learn deep dive planning, organization, procedures, techniques and hazards. Also learn about different equipment such as pony/stage bottles, H-valves, Doubles and more. You'll try some of this equipment in practice sessions.
- Four open water dives that range from 60 - 130 feet.
- Gain experience with diving deep under the direct, professional supervision of a PADI Instructor.
- Required Equipment List: In addition to the PADI Deep Diver eLearning, you'll need all of your basic Scuba gear including: mask, fins, snorkel, exposure suit (drysuit recommended), weights, regulator with SPG & alternate air source, BCD, computer, dive knife or tool, slate with pencil plus compass, whistle, SMB and 2 lights (primary & back-up). You'll also need a reel. Your Instructor may suggest other gear appropriate for deep diving in your area or other locations you may be considering. Familiarity with the PADI RDP tables is an asset.
- Certification counts toward the PADI Master Scuba Diver rating.

Prerequisites: PADI (or equivalent) Advanced Certification (must be over 15). Drysuits are essentially required due to dive times and temperatures. This course may be done on FNF Group trips in warmer water. Please enquire at the shop about this option.

Cost: \$350 Course + e-Learning (\$206), Plus tax. Accommodations & Quarry Fees Extra. Rental gear not included. Can be done on a FNF Travel group trip as well.

Schedule:

Session 1 @ 6:00pm - Review & Dive planning at Float N' Flag Dive Centre.

Session 2 @ 5:00pm - Gullivers - Pre-trip skills dive.

Session 3+4 - Dives will be held in Gilboa, Ohio. Hotel Rooms will already be booked, and the quarry fees will be paid in advance. Passports will be required.

Note to Participants: Additional details will be provided for you regarding the accommodations. You will be responsible to pay for accommodation & Travel expenses. Air/Nitrox fills are also student responsibilities.
