Pre-requisites

- PADI Advanced Open Water Diver
- 30 Logged Dives
- 18 Years Old
- Equipment - Sidemount BCD, two fully independent first and second stages each with an SPG, at least one of which has a 7 foot second stage hose. At least one first stage must also have a low pressure inflator hose to supply air to the BCD and a Drysuit whip as appropriate to diving environment & gear.
