Native to the Pacific Ocean, lionfish are progressively invading the North-Eastern Atlantic and the Caribbean, where they have no natural predators. Learn what action is needed to control the lionfish population, and during two scuba dives, learn practical ways to safely and humanely capture and euthanize these fish.

The Fun Part

You'll learn a lot about Lionfish, but where it's at is getting out there with a sling and a ZooKeeper and taking these bad boys off the reef! We'll often do a Lionfish feast at the end of the week to reward your efforts!

What You Learn

During your PADI Invasive Lionfish Tracker certification course, you learn about:

- The dramatic growth and impact of this invasive species in North America and the Caribbean
- Where to find Lionfish on the reef
- How to use a pole spear/sling and other capture methods for Lionfish, including safety precautions, hazards and First Aid techniques for stings
- How to euthanize Lionfish
- How delicious they are!

Prerequisites: If you're a PADI (Junior) Open Water Diver who is at least 12 years old, you can enroll in the Invasive Lionfish Tracker Specialty course.

Cost: \$200 + tax. Materials are included and will be provided upon registration. You'll receive a 100% AWARE Certification card and fees will be donated to PADI AWARE to help continue their great work at protecting our oceans!
